SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

These include but are not limited to:-

- 1. Delivery of a best-practice Classroom Music Program, Years 6-12.
- 2. Assist in the organisation of Senior School concerts, soirees, and ensembles
- 3. Continuous reporting regular instalments to students regarding their learning progress and achievements
- 4. Frequent updating of class and course pages on the myKDS portal
- 5. Teach additional music classes as required.
- 6. Lodge curriculum documents with Vice-Principal Teaching & Learning in a timely manner.

- 1. Support the ethos of the School, both through participation in a range of School events, as well as in the nature and style of musical events produced.
- 2. Be a role model for best practice Teaching and Learning in Music.
- 3. Ability and availability to teach at a range of levels.
